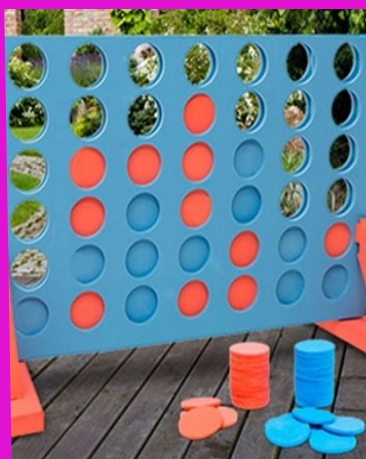
# Summer Holiday Family Play Sessions
