## What have we been learning?

**Reception....** This week we learnt 2D shape names and their properties. We have also read a bit more from our story 'Bog Baby'. A couple of the challenges we have completed this week have been creating pictures from shapes and making a 'bog baby' from clay. At home, please notice triangles, squares, rectangles and circles around the house and outside. Talk to your child about what these shapes look like.

Year 2... This week as mathematicians we learnt about length in metres and centimetres. We also wrote our own fantastic pirate stories. We started a new enquiry 'What is home?' and went on a caterpillar hunt! At home, please help your child practise their 10, 5, 2 and 3 times tables.

Year 4... we performed our play 'A big Green Adventure' and it was a hit! We were all very impressed by the effort put in by all children. Have a restful half term and be ready to come back feeling energised for term 4! Help at home by practising your times tables!

Year 5 ... This week, year 5 learned about finding fractions of amounts. In English, we wrote our own stories in a historical setting such as The Stone Age or The Iron Age. In Enquiry, we explored reasons for homelessness and we baked some cakes to help some of the homeless people in Bristol. Help at home by supporting your child to practise their joined up handwriting. Year 1... This week in Enquiry, we have been creating our games to share with Year 3. As Mathematicians we have started to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. As Authors, we have learnt to write letters. Both classes have also enjoyed a well earnt class treat! Help at home by reading every day over the holidays and practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s ready for next term!

Year 3... This week as mathematicians we continued to find fractions of amounts. As authors we wrote persuasive letters to Ms Ramsay. We were also artists and engineers for our enquiry and we finished making a magnetic game. Help at home by reading with your child and encouraging them to practise one of their times table columns each day!

Year 6... This week, Eagle class were at Into University – we went to We the Curious and today we graduated at Bristol University! Kestrel have been converting between different units of measure and have written a non-chronological report about rewilding animals. Help at home by continuing to read with your child and checking they are completing their times tables books.

Term ends today, 15th February. Term 4 starts on Monday 25th February.
