

This week we got straight back into our learning. Lots of children have been reading with Mrs Naushahi in the Hub as well as in class. Some lucky families joined a great trip to the SS Great Britain over the break and we enjoyed hearing all about it from the children. Please makesure you are checking your child's book bag and keeping up with their reading journals. We love to hear what you've been up to on Tapestry as well.

This week Year 1 started their new enquiry: 'How do we play in different ways?' and loved exploring toys from the past. We also enjoyed asking a visitor questions about their toys! Ask your children what they remember! We also celebrated Diwali and made beautiful diya lamps. Check them out on twitter! Please read with your child 5 times a week. Practise number bonds to10.

Year 2

This week Year 2 started their new book 'Pattan's Pumpkin' and their new enquiry 'How do plants grow?'. We planted bean seeds and had a look at what was inside a pumpkin – we roasted the seeds and loved tasting them. We thought they tasted of popcorn! Please read with your child 5 times a week. Practise counting forwards and backwards from 100. Practise adding 2 digit and 1 digit numbers e.g. 36 + 7

This week we started reading our new book 'The Pebble in my pocket'. We learnt some new vocabulary linked to Volcanoes and we beagn to add and subtract with exchanges. We enjoyed taking part in a fire safety workshop where we learnt what to do in an emergency and ways to stay safe during Bonfire night. Please practise the 2, 5, 3 and 4 times tables. Encourage your child to read every day and ask them questions about the book.

We have had a fantastic start to our term. We started reading our new class book 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl, which provided us great links to our Enquiry learning on 'who is predator, who is prey?'. A mathematicians we practised our 6 times tables and found efficient ways to subtract. We also had lots of fun at our first swimming lesson of the term Help at home by continuing to practise your 6 times-table!

We have had a fantastic start to our term. We started reading a new text called 'Street Child', which is about a boy in Victorian London. As mathematicians we practised our times tables and learnt about factors. We also started preparing for our performance at the end of this term. Please help your child with their homework spellings ready for our weekly Monday test.



Kestrel class have had an amazing week at Into University learning all about what university has to offer as well as finding out all about WW2 whilst Eagle class have been gewtting stuck in to term 2's learning! Please help your child with their

homework spellings ready for our weekly Tuesday test. Use Times Table Rockstars to practise tables up to 12. Make sure your child is reading every day.
